



## A VOICE OF SANITY AND PARTNERSHIP

To a greater or lesser extent, most *Rabbonim* prefer to speak about Torah and avoid the “hot topics” of current events. Those involved in *Kiruv Rechokim* are especially obligated to sidestep subjects which may turn newcomers away.

And yet:

- We are called bigots for dividing prayers by gender, much less for insisting that gender is determined biologically.
- Radicals claim it is “Jewish” to oppose Torah values, offending Jews and Christians who look to the Torah for guidance on marriage, gender, life and other matters.
- The same radicals increasingly oppose Jewish life in Judea, in Eretz Yisroel.
- Jews, especially the visibly religious, are under attack as never before in the United States.

Clearly, a voice is needed to push back against those promoting an anti-Torah ideology when they claim to represent “the Jewish view,” and communicate genuine Torah values to both legislators and the public. It was for that reason that Coalition for Jewish Values was created nearly five years ago, and why we have enjoyed phenomenal growth, interacting with media, federal and state legislators, other Jewish and pro-values organizations, and the general public.

We work to advance and support traditional Torah values. Rabbonim and sympathetic congregants will receive ongoing chizuk from knowing someone is doing this work, seeing what we are doing, and having a resource when needed.
